Beef Promotion and Research Program PRIVATE TREATY SALES CHECKOFF INVESTMENT FORM

The Beef Promotion and Research Act and Order requires that a \$1.00 per head assessment on cattle marketed shall be paid by the producer of the cattle. In the absence of a market agency (market, dealer, packer, etc.) acting as the collecting person, it becomes the producer's responsibility to remit the assessment to the qualified state beef council in their state. Assessments are to be remitted to the above address by the 15th day of the month following the month in which the cattle were purchased. Additional forms are available from the N.D. Beef Commission.
